

Along Highway 60...

Overnight Parking For extended winter camping trips, you must park your vehicle in one of several ploughed areas (indicated on this map by the symbol **P**). Vehicles left overnight on the shoulder of Highway 60 may be ticketed by the Ontario Provincial Police and towed away at the owner's expense.

Toilets in Winter Heated washrooms are available daily at the West and East Gates, and at the Visitor Centre when the Centre is open to the public. Outdoor privies are located along Highway 60 at the Western Uplands Backpacking Trail (at Km 3), Mizzy Lake Trail (North from Km 15.4), Minnesing Ski Trail (at Km 23), Cache Lake (at Km 23.5), Track & Tower Trail (at Km 25), Highland Backpacking Trail (at Km 29.7), Sunday Lake Dog Sled Trail (at Km 40.3), and Leaf Lake Ski Trail (at Km 54.5) parking lots.

Watch the clock! Allow enough time to be off trails and back at your vehicle before dusk. During winter months, do not start out on any trail after 3:00 p.m.

Cell phone coverage is not Park-wide; generally, it is limited to 3 kilometres on each side of Highway 60 and, even in this area, coverage can be "none" to "limited."

Kilometre markers at one-kilometre intervals along Highway 60 indicate distances from the West Gate (at Km 0). By referring to kilometre markers and this map, you can easily locate Park facilities.

Visibly display your Park permit on the dash of your vehicle at all times!
